Foothills Christian Youth Camp 2022 Bessie Road Baptist Church Camp

Dear Parents & Campers,

We are excited about our upcoming encampment at Foothills Christian Youth Camp. We would like to get your child registered as soon as possible. Even if you are a returning camper and parent, please take time to read over this in its entirety to become better acquainted with our new plans.

Please make plans to attend! Camp will be held **Tuesday June 14th - Friday June 17th**

Youth ages seven (7) through Sixteen (16) may register for this camp. We do not recommend the attendance of younger campers as we have carefully evaluated our camp and have found that the activities are safer and more appealing to those at least seven years of age. However, if you insist that your child who is younger than the age of seven attends, a <u>Parent</u> or <u>Mature Sibling</u> must accompany the camper. For the benefit and safety of all campers, youth older than sixteen may not register for this camp as they do not enjoy the same games of the age group seven to sixteen and the height difference often causes a problem during games. Youth over the cut-off age will only attend if they have been asked to attend as a team leader or counselor. Please, however, understand that this is not intended to forget those over the age of sixteen, as teenagers; also they need something to keep them busy in a Godly, Christian atmosphere and, also keeping them away from the world.

We will depart from Bessie Road Baptist Church, 575 Bessie Road Piedmont SC 29673 at 9:00am. However, all campers should arrive at the church at 8:30am with a parent to check-in and prepare for departure. Upon arrival, campers will be issued labels for luggage, notified of transportation vehicle assignment, and confirm any details. Parents should turn over any medications to the designated camp staff at this time. Every camper MUST come through the Camper Check-In line; no exceptions will be made. There are important reasons for this including that the camper has to be informed of his transportation vehicle assignment.

We will arrive back to Bessie Road Baptist Church around 6:00pm on Friday, June 17th, 2021.

It is imperative that you review the rules and expectations and review them with your camper as they will be strictly enforced in an effort to create a Godly, Christian atmosphere and to avoid any worldly distractions. Our Campers will be allowed to bring their cell phones but are only allowed to have them at certain periods of the day and will be taken up when they are not allowed. Due to fairness, we will ask if they have a phone at check in to insure that we know who's has been taken up, and redistributed.

The Registration Fee for camp is \$40 per camper. This covers the fuel to travel to camp, a Camp T-Shirt, Ten (10) meals, snacks, a Trip to an amusement park and the campground and facilities use fee. This Registration Fee is not profit-gaining for the camp or church. You may submit \$40 in cash or check (made payable to Bessie Road Baptist Church) along with your Registration Form. Please Give The Completed form and Money to Tyler Brewer. Also, if you are planning to get a T-Shirt please register by the Camp T-Shirt deadline, Sunday, May 22nd, to be guaranteed a camp t-shirt. Please understand that we will NOT order extra t-shirts and if you register after the Camp T-Shirt Deadline, you are not guaranteed a t-shirt. You may, however, continue to register for camp after May 22nd through the Late Registration.

Deadline as long as we have vacancy at camp, but you will not be guaranteed a camp t-shirt. Unfortunately, absolutely no one can register after the Late Registration Deadline on the Wednesday before camp, June 8th, because of transportation arrangements.

AMUSEMENT PARK EXPECTATIONS

At the end of camp each year we close camp out with a trip to one of our local amusement parks ex. Frankies Fun Park, Sky-zone. The price of the park is included in the cost of the price of camp although if your child chooses to bring there own money to buy snacks or drinks or pay for extra games that is okay, but your child must keep up with his/her own money. No leader or director is responsible for a child's extra money. Also we expect your child to act in a Christian Godly manner while out at these parks if a child is not cooperating or misbehaving then they will be told to sit out and will not be allowed to play. Permission form to the amusement park of our choosing will be given out at a later date, if you do not sign one for your child unfortunately your child cannot participate, so please be attentive as we get those permission forms out.

RULES & EXPECTATIONS:

- Boy-girl relationships are NOT allowed and will NOT be tolerated (including public displays of affection)
- Campers must abide by dormitory curfews in order to get showers before nightly devotions.
- Campers must attend all services, and participate in all activities when physically able.
- Personal hygiene and dormitory and campground cleanliness must be kept.
- Do not use profanity or dirty language.
- Do not physically or emotionally abuse others (including fighting, teasing, name-calling, starting rumors, etc.)
- Do not horse play, run, or jump on beds in the dorms
- Do not have a bad attitude or display negativity
- Obey all authority figures including every counselor and team leader
- Respect everyone and yourself
- Use polite manners towards everyone

(*Example: Please be sure to thank the cooks at each meal)

• Smile and display a positive, Godly, Christian attitude out of respect for our Lord, Jesus Christ and others.

PROHIBITED ITEMS (if found, these items will be confiscated until the end of camp for the benefit and safety of all campers):

- Alcoholic beverages, drugs, or tobacco products (this includes cigarettes and drug paraphernalia)
- Unregistered medications (*Note: any needed over-the-shelf or prescribed medications must be turned over to the designated camp staff and registered by a parent upon camper drop-off and NONE should be left in the possession of campers)
- Guns, knives, or any type of weapons
- Inappropriate or immodest clothing (including worldly slogans)

<u>All rules, expectations, and dress codes will be strictly enforced.</u> <u>Please understand that the</u> <u>camp staff has to be strict for safety purposes and also remember the Lord, Jesus Christ is the</u> <u>canter of our camp.</u>
